Booking Arrangements

Deposit

A \$350.00 non refundable deposit is required at the time of booking to reserve your tee times.

Booking Agreement

- Once details have been finalized, a booking agreement will be sent to the Tournament Contact.
- The booking agreement must be received with **signature** at least fourteen (14) days prior to the scheduled event.
- The total number of players is to be provided fourteen (14) days prior to the event. Final numbers must be provided six (6) days prior to the event, with a reduction in numbers up to 15% allowed. This number is the minimum number of players charged.
- Event material may be forwarded to the above address, attention the office.
- The Truro Golf Club does not accept responsibility for any goods, lost, stolen or damaged, prior to, during or after any stay or functions at the Truro Golf Club.
- **No passes are permitted to be used as payment.**

Rules, Etiquette and Regulations

- Proper dress and good conduct on the course and in the clubhouse.
 - On the course, play in an orderly manner. Do not hit your ball until preceding players are out of range.
 - When looking for a lost ball, allow following players to play through when they come within range and make sure that they are well out of range when you resume play.
 - Golf bags, carts and cars have no place on tees, greens or aprons.
 - DO NOT LITTER - Wrappers, boxes, cans or bottles should only be placed in waste cans provided for that purpose; not on the course or behind trees.
 - Please replace your divots on fairways and repair ball marks on greens.
 - Be considerate. Do not move, stand close to or behind the ball or hole when another player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
 - Rake sand after playing balls out of bunkers.
 - Two or more players must not use or play out of the same set of clubs. Each player must have their own set.
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Dress Code Regulations

As your event's coordinator please insure your guests meet our regulations before arriving to avoid incidents
Members/guests are expected to dress to fulfill the needs of comfort and decorum, and must conform to the following regulations:

Jeans are acceptable provided they are neat, not cut off or torn, and not dragging on the ground

Shoes and socks/sockettes must be worn at all times

Shorts are acceptable providing they are mid-thigh in length. No cut-off shorts, sweatpants, bathing suits, gym shorts or gym pants are allowed

Women are not permitted halter tops or short tennis shorts

Men are not permitted tank tops or sleeveless shirts, and removal of shirts is not permitted

Anyone violating these regulations will be directed to remove themselves from the Course

Soft Spikes are mandatory or flat soled shoes

In interest of all golfers on the course, please play without t delay.
Under normal circumstances,

Average Round length in 2006 3 hours 47 minutes
no round should take more than 4 hours 15 minutes

Here are some tips to help keep pace while on the course:

- Play ready golf, be ready to go, hit when ready
- Any pre shot routine should be done as much as possible while other players are hitting
- Always position your clubs around tees and greens that does not require you to take extra time to retrieve them
- Do not compile score on the putting green
- No your limits (5 minutes, Rules of Golf) and be aware of other groups when searching for lost balls
- Continuous putting, if the ball is close be sure to finish the hole instead of marking
