### TGC Handicap Committee FYI

What is the purpose of the RCGA Handicap System and why is it important for members of the TGC to have an accurate handicap?

It enables golfers of differing abilities to compete on an equitable basis. It is the best method to give you the opportunity to compete fairly with any golfer, on any course. The system is only as fair as the golfers who use it, however, and assumes that you will be honest, try to make the best score on every hole, and submit every acceptable score for peer review.

As a member of the Truro Golf Club it is your responsibility to preserve the integrity of the game by posting a score for every acceptable round as soon as possible after completion of the round so your RCGA Handicap Factor is current.

### TGC MATCHES

Club members are asked to note that all club match draws have now been posted in the lower hallway outside the pro shop. Matches are to be completed by the date indicated for each round. Failure to complete the assigned match by the given deadline will result in a coin flip to determine the winner. If your phone number is not already on the draw sheet please post it to make communication easier for scheduling matches.

Participants are asked to pick up a rules sheet in the pro shop before their match. This should eliminate any confusion over handicaps, extra holes, local rules, what tees to play etc...
