## Caralynn's Corner by Caralynn Cullen

*Well I'm sure most people have noticed by now the raccoon and grub damage we are getting on some of the back 9 fairways. Normally the raccoons dig/peel in the rough, but due to a very dry year all the grubs are migrating to irrigated areas on the course (mainly the fairways). We have sprayed an insecticide to control the population, but there has been some thinning and dieback of the turf.*



*In the later part of next week, we will be closing the driving range down for repairs to the net and the driving range deck. We will also be fixing the irrigation break at #5 tee, In order to do the repairs we need to isolate that section. This means the front 9 washroom will be closed until the leak is fixed...shouldn't be more than a couple of days at the most. We will post a sign of the exact date when everything will take place next week.*
