The Truro Golf Course is one of the premier golf courses in central Nova Scotia and has developed a strong reputation for its excellent customer service and superb course conditions. Founded in 1903, the club is entering its second century of great golf. In 1930 the original nine holes were remodeled into a championship nine hole layout by the famous golf course architect, Stanley Thompson. It was expanded to 18 holes in 1967, again renovated in 1985, and again in 2012 to its current championship configuration.

The golf course is located in the heart of the Town of Truro and serves a membership base of nearly 550. It has been host to many tournaments over the years including the inaugural Maritime Amateur Championship in 1911, the 1975 Peter Jackson Championship, numerous Nova Scotia Amateur and Senior Amateur Championships, the Canadian Senior Championship in 1997 and the Canadian Senior Match-play Championship in 2003, the Nova Scotia Mens Amateur Championship in 2011 and the World Blind Golf Championships in 2012 and Canadian Blind Championships.

The successful candidate will be joining a team that is focused on delivering impeccable customer service on a daily basis. To ensure continuous career development, the successful candidate will participate in all facets of the operation including pro shop and back shop operations, tournament planning and organizing, junior golf program, private and group instruction, merchandise sales, club fitting, scheduling, budgeting, etc.
